

iSmart Challenge Video Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. iSmart Challenge Video Competition (the Contest) is organized by Tunku Azizah Knowledge Centre (the Organizer).
2. The Contest starts from 25 February 2019 and the closing date for submission is by 14 March 2019. Entries received after 5.00pm on 14 March 2019 or are damaged, corrupted, incomplete or illegible will not be accepted and will be disqualified.
3. The Organizer may at its sole and absolute discretion extend the contest period at any time without any prior notice to any party whatsoever. Unless otherwise varied to the contrary by the Organizer, any participation in the Contest during the extended period (if any) shall be governed by the Terms and Conditions set out herein which shall remain in full force and effect at all times.
4. The Organizer reserves the right to modify the contest mechanisms, withdraw or terminate this Contest at any time at its sole and absolute discretion without prior notices to any person.

Eligibility

5. The Contest is open to all Universiti Kuala Lumpur students, age 18 and above, active students in Universiti Kuala Lumpur only ("Eligible Participants").
6. Employees of the Organizer, its affiliates and/or related companies and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate in the Contest.

Submission Requirements

7. Eligible Participants are allowed to submit more than one (1) entry. To participate, Eligible Participants must comply with each of the following:
 - i. Eligible Participants MUST provide their Full Name, Identity Card number, valid Contact Number and Email address (Incomplete entries will not be considered).
 - ii. Each submission will be tied to one Eligible Participant. In the event that a group works together on a submission, the submission will be entered under the name of a primary participant. However, the complete details of group members must be provided.
 - iii. All entries must be the Eligible Participants' original works and no part or component thereof is copied from any other work or material.
 - iv. The dialogue may be in any languages spoken in Malaysia. However, non-English submissions must be accompanied by English subtitles.
 - v. All costs and expenses in connection with the production of the entry and the participation of this contest shall be fully borne by the Eligible Participants.
 - vi. Entries will be judged equally based on (A) Content; (B) Creativity; and (C) Originality to the theme of 'book that inspired me'. Judges' decision is final, conclusive and binding. No further appeal, enquiry and/or correspondence will be entertained.

Format of the Video Submission

8. Every entry video should consist of the following:
 - i. Title – "iSmart Challenge" followed by title of video
 - ii. The video must be in one of the following formats:-
WebM | MEG4 | 3GP | MOV | AVI | MPEGS | WMV | FLV
 - iii. Recommended video resolution is 640p x 480p. Video quality must be clear on a full computer screen.

- iv. Audio quality must be clear – on site audio feed or narration is allowed.
- v. Maximum video duration is **three (3) minutes**, longer video are accepted, but judging will only cover for first three minutes.

How to Submit

- 9. All complete entries MUST be submitted to Tunku Azizah Knowledge Centre as well as UniKL campuses Learning Hubs.
- 10. Video also can be submitted via social media platform, submission via social media must tag UniKL Library Facebook page as well as the following hashtag:-

- 11. Alternatively, you may send your complete entries via online file transfer to library@unikl.edu.my
- 12. All submission must comply with the submission requirements and format video in accordance with sections 7 and 8 of these Terms and Conditions.

Prizes

- 13. The prize winners will receive the following:

Grand Prize – Tablet/smartphone worth RM 1,000
15 x Consolation Prizes – Movie Ticket worth RM 30

The top 20 best submission also stand a chance to be nominated as 'UniKL Reading Icon' (UniKL student's representative), and he/she will be invited to represent University should there be any national competition in near future.

- 14. The Organizer reserves the right at its absolute discretion to substitute any of the prizes with alternative prizes of similar value, at any time without prior notice. All prizes are given on an "As is" basis and are not exchangeable or sold for cash, credit, other items or voucher in part or in full and are non-transferable to any other person.

Eligible Winners

- 15. The eligibility to win the Contest is on the condition that Eligible Participants fully comply with the Terms and Conditions as stated herein.
- 16. Incomplete entries and/or the failure to fulfil all or any of the Terms and Conditions will automatically disqualify the Eligible Participants from the Contest without prior notice.
- 17. The Top 20 best submissions as determined by the judges in their sole discretion will be judged for its ranking of the prizes. The judges' decision is final, conclusive and binding.
- 18. Eligible Participants may submit more than one (1) entry but only one (1) prize will be given for each of the Top 10 prize winners.

Announcement of the Winners

- 19. The winners of the Contest will be notified via email no later than 18 March 2019 or such other date as decided by the Organizer at its absolute discretion, to present in person at the Prize Presentation venue to collect their prize. However, the Organizer reserves the right to change the venue and/or timing of Prize Presentation at its sole discretion without prior notification.

20. In the event that a submission created by a group (and submitted by a Primary Entrant) is declared the winner in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, the prize will be awarded to the primary participant and it will be the responsibility of the primary participant to distribute the prize.
21. The winners are fully responsible for any injuries, damages or claims as a result of or arising from their participation in the Contest, usage of their prize and/or collection of their prize. All transportation, accommodation, personal cost and/or any other costs and/or any other related expenses that are incurred to participate in this Contest and/or to redeem the prize are the sole responsibility of the Eligible Participants and winners.

General Terms

22. By entering the Contest, Eligible Participants shall agree to appear in internet, videos, photographs, write-ups which may be used in advertising (any form of media) or other materials by the Organizer. Eligible Participants shall not be entitled to any payment for such use, or for any re-use; and acknowledge that all copyright, including the right to reproduce likeness or image shall belong to the Organizer absolutely; and to release and discharge the Organizer from any claims in relation to the Organizer's use of likeness or image.
23. The Organizer reserves the absolute right to disqualify any individual that it determines to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest, to be acting in breach or potential breach of this Contest's Terms and Conditions.
24. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel, modify suspend or delay the Contest in the event of unforeseen circumstances beyond its reasonable control.
25. By participating in this Contest, all Eligible Participants hereby warrant that all statements personal details given are true, correct, accurate and complete and that they have read and understood all the Terms and Conditions of this Contest and agree to be unconditionally bound by it.
26. By participating in this Contest, all Eligible Participants agree to defend, indemnify and hold the Organizer harmless from and against any suits, claims, losses, damages and expenses, including reasonable legal fees that may be arise from or in connection with the Contest.
27. The Organizer reserves the right to change, amend, delete or add to any of these Terms and Conditions without prior notice and the Eligible Participants will be bound to such changes.
